West Side Coat Closet ~ As the weather changes and temperatures drop, we once again pull out our coats and jackets. Due to its small space, our coat closet will remain closed. Please keep your coats with you and use the pew in front of you for them.



Lebanon Warrior Closet ~ This November we will be partnering with the Lebanon Warrior Closet in their efforts to help clothe families in need in our community. The Warrior Closet is run out of Berry Intermediate School and is currently helping 4-5 families per week. We will be collecting specific items that are in highest demand: 1) New boys and girls underwear in all sizes including adult, 2) new socks in all sizes including adult, 3) basic hygiene

items such as sample/travel size toothpaste, mouth wash, tooth brushes, shampoo, bar soap, and deodorant. A collection bin will be placed outside on the porch.
