Genesis 28:10-22 (Isaiah 40:28-31)  
(Page 19 in the Pew Bible)

Joshua led Israel to erect 12 stones in the Jordan River to commemorate God's deliverance. Jesus said if the crowds quieted down, the stones would cry out.
