West Side Background Checks – Since 2009 we have administered background checks on all volunteers that work with our children. Since that time, we have not updated our method of collecting information and processing the background checks, until now. We have recently updated our process with Protect My Ministry to incorporate an online portal that members can use to provide their information themselves without turning it in to the office. This update also comes with a sexual abuse training video to help us recognize and prevent any abuse from taking place. Because of these changes, we are starting from scratch with our background check process. We are requiring all West Side Christians who serve with our children to submit a new background check, watch the training video, and take the training test. 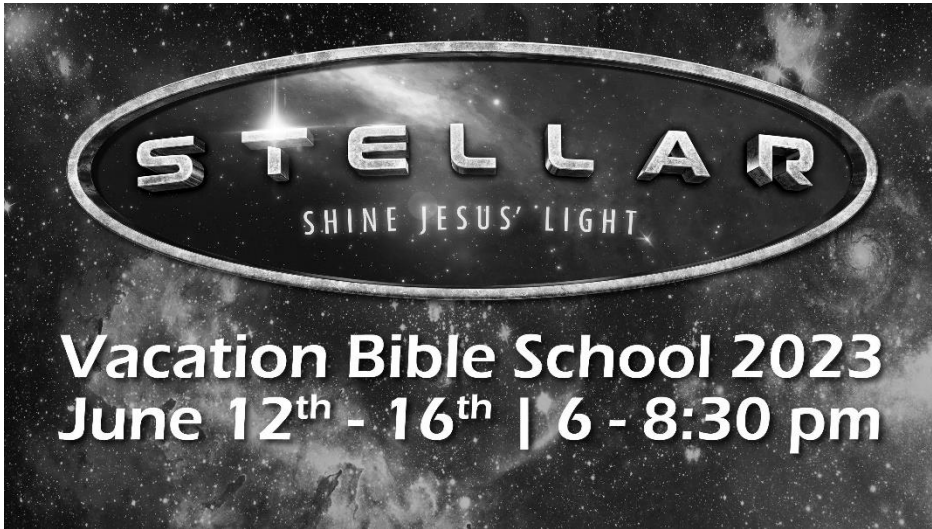
Wednesday Night Bible Study ~ Join us every Wednesday at 6:30 PM, studying “Characters of the Bible.”
