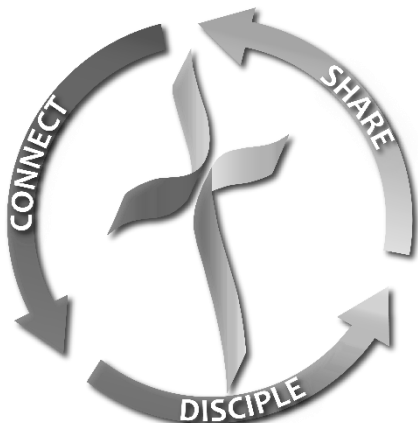

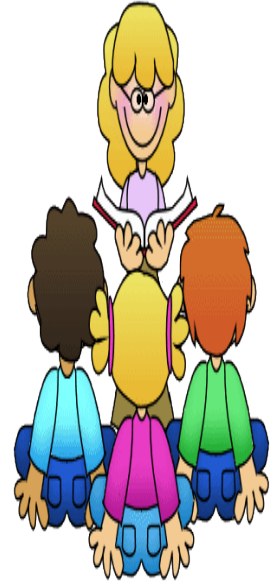

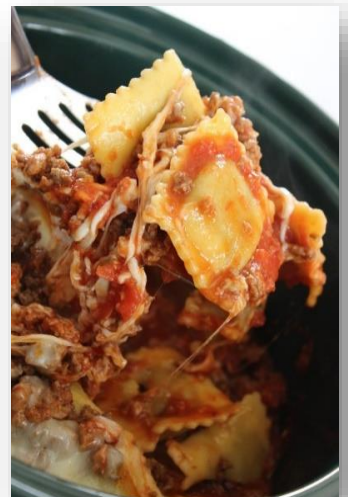

Crockpot Ravioli Casserole

20 oz. Frozen Four Cheese Ravioli 24 oz. Pasta Sauce
4 cups Shredded Mozzarella Cheese 1 pound Italian Sausage (cooked and drained)

1. Spray inside of a 6-quart crockpot with non-stick cooking spray.
2. Pour ½ jar of pasta sauce in crockpot.
3. Spread ½ of ravioli in an even layer on top of sauce.
4. Spread ½ of the cooked Italian sausage over the ravioli.
5. Spread out 2 cups of mozzarella over the sausage.
6. Repeat layers.
7. Cook on high for 1 hr. 45 min. or on low for 3 hr. 30 min.

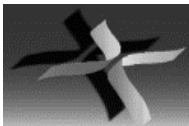
