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Some Food For Thought

In the fall of 2011 our leadership felt that God was leading our church to try something new and different in our effort to love and lead people to a life changing relationship with Jesus Christ. We felt that God was moving us to launch a second worship service that would be contemporary in worship style. In January of 2012 we recruited several individuals to see if we had the talents and abilities to put together a worship band. The answer to that was a resounding yes, and in April 2012 we moved from a church with one worship service and worship style to a church with two worship services and two worship styles. Since that time God has moved and worked in some really amazing ways, all while teaching us to follow Him and trust His leadership.

While many good things have taken place due to our two worship services, there are few things that our two worship services have made evident. The first is that many of our workers, especially those who work with our youth, are very taxed by the service structure that we offer. Along those same lines we have struggled to have a children's program for our k-5th grade students during our 11:00 worship service. In addition, our Sunday School period is simply too short for teaching.

Again, we feel God moving and leading us to make an alteration to our worship structure. To help alieviate scheduling issues, to help create a program for our k-5th during our traditional service, to add more teaching time in Sunday School, and to help our contemporary service attract more people with a slight time adjustment, on September 13th our service times will change. Following is the time breakdown: 9:30 a.m. Contemporary service with an adult Sunday School offering and 11:00 a.m. Traditional service with an adult Sunday School offering. At this time the previous information is what we do know.

Here is what we do not know. We do not know what our children's structure will look like from these time changes. We are asking our Youth and Education Teams to look at the structure and implement a program that will minister to our kids. One idea that has been discussed is offering a Sunday School type program for all of our kids during our 9:30 Contemporary service and a Jr. Church/Extended Session program during our 11:00 Traditional service, or vice versa. At this point we are only in the planning stages of this element.

So why now? The first reason we are making this change now is in response to our teachers who have shared over and over again how taxing the structure is. Also, at this time we have many children who are moving from our Pre-school program to our k-5th program. With this move, at our 11:00 service, we have no programming during worship that geared for them. Finally, we wanted to align this with the hiring of a part-time Children's Minister as we will ask them to take an active role in helping with the planning.

I am excited for this change to take place because I feel it will make our Sunday morning structure a little less taxing on our workers and help us as we constantly seek to love and lead people to a life changing relationship with Jesus Christ.
