### Some Food For Thought

I am not a mechanic but every now and then I play one in my spare time. Sometimes I really enjoy working on my cars and other times I do it because I am too cheap to pay someone else. Over the last two weeks I have tackled two major problems on Crystal's van; replacing the rear brakes and fixing the non-working air conditioning system. Both projects threw me unexpected twists and took longer than I had anticipated, but I can happily say, both are finished.

There is something wonderful about looking back and being able to say, "I made that" or "I fixed that." That's because God created us to work. Back in the very beginning man was placed in the Garden of Eden to care for it. Genesis 2:15 tells us, "The LORD God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it." Friends, this is before the fall. This is before sin entered the picture and God added to our toil. We are created in God's image and part of that is working, creating, and fixing. There is something incredibly satisfying about working hard on a project and seeing it through.

Let's be a little introspective for a moment. When was the last time you worked on a project with God's kingdom in mind and felt that sort of satisfaction? When was the last time you worked with other Christians and were able to step back and happily proclaim, "I did that" or "I was a part of that?" When was the last time you were a part of a group studying God's Word together, walking deeper together, perhaps even leading someone to a new understanding in Christ?

This year we are talking about being All In. Nearly 40 West Side Christians signed cards and declared that they were all in. This is our June newsletter. We are now halfway through 2017. So, let's get the thermometer out and take our temperature. How are you doing? In what ways have you actively taken steps to be All In? We defined three areas where we are asking West Side Christians to be All In ... in study, in service, and in worship. We asked each West Side Christian to study at least one hour each week, to serve at least one hour each week, and to worship at least one hour each week. So how are you doing? In what ways have you taken steps to be All In?



Perhaps this year, one way you said I'm All In is by serving at the Lebanon Food pantry. Perhaps you decided you are going to attend a Bible study and have joined our men's and women's groups on Wednesday nights. Perhaps you are making a point to be here more Sunday mornings than you miss. Maybe you have decided that you are going to serve by helping take care of West Side's physical property.

Perhaps you made one of those decisions, or maybe even something entirely different, but you have yet to put it into practice. What is keeping you from committing. What is it you need to sacrifice in your life to fulfill your decision to be All In? What is keeping you from being able to stand back and say, "I was a part of that?" What is keeping you from reaching the satisfaction of completing your commitment?

Let me challenge you to take your temperature and continue your pursuit of being All In.
