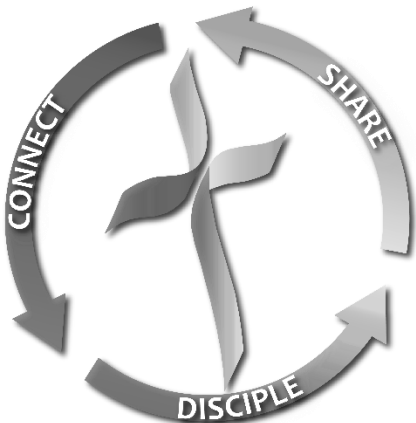

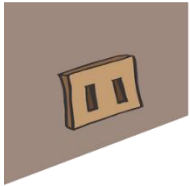

CCU provides a Christ-centered, liberal arts education that prepares students to bring a Christian worldview into their chosen fields of study and build meaningful, successful careers. In addition to traditional campus programs, CCU has partnered with Point University to bring more than 45 online programs to students at CCU and in the greater Cincinnati area. Through Point, CCU and Cincinnati area students have access to 100% online associate, bachelor's, and master's degrees in a wide range of high-demand fields, such as business administration, child development, information technology, marketing, and ministry.

The history of CCU began on September 23, 1924. A new school began that day with "it's first session in two brick buildings. Two things were evident from the beginning; first, the Bible was taught with the earnest desire of arriving at its true meaning...and second, men and women whose earnest desire was to serve God, were received in classes and given work they most needed."

This May, CCU had their 94th commencement exercises. The class of 2018 are now making their mark on the world with their chosen careers. God has a plan for their lives and they are answering God's call to go out and spread the good news of the gospel in their communities and work place. Some Food for Thought

When Crystal and I lived in Virginia we made the short trip up to Colonial Williamsburg for the day with my family who was visiting us. That day, as we stood outside the Capitol Building, we were treated to a reading of the Declaration of Independence, just as it would have been done in July of 1776!

That document is an important document to our nation. It declared our independence from Great Britain. It, along with our Constitution, and Bill of Rights, may perhaps be the three most important documents in our nations history. Because of their importance, they are on display for the American public to see in the Rotunda of the National Archives Building in our capitol.

As Christians, we have our own document that we find to be very important. I would even argue, as great as the Declaration, Constitution, and Bill of rights are, our document is that much more important. I believe the Bible is the greatest single document mankind has ever laid his eyes on.

The Bible is God's communication to us. The God of the Heavens, the Creator of all things, has chosen to give us His written word to guide and direct our lives, to help us know Him and His desires for His creation. There is no other document like it.

But, there is also a lot of confusion about it. For the next several months, I want to use this space to share some of the reason I find the Bible to be the most important document as well as debunk some misconceptions about modern translations of the text.

To begin, let's lay some basic ground work about what the Bible is. The Bible is a collection of sixty-six different books, written by some forty different human authors, over a roughly fifteen-hundred-year period. The Bible tells the story of God's creation, man's sin, and God's work to redeem mankind from our sin. The Bible is divided into two separate sections; the Old Testament and the New Testament. The Old Testament deals with the history of the nation of Israel as they prepared the world for Jesus, and the New Testament deals with the work of Jesus and the church He created. The Bible was written in two primary languages; Hebrew in the Old Testament, and Greek in the New Testament.

Over the next couple of months, I will use this section of the newsletter to teach about our English translations, the inerrancy of the Bible, God's purpose with the Bible, and many other topics. If there is something you would like me to cover, please let me know. In Christ ~ Michael
