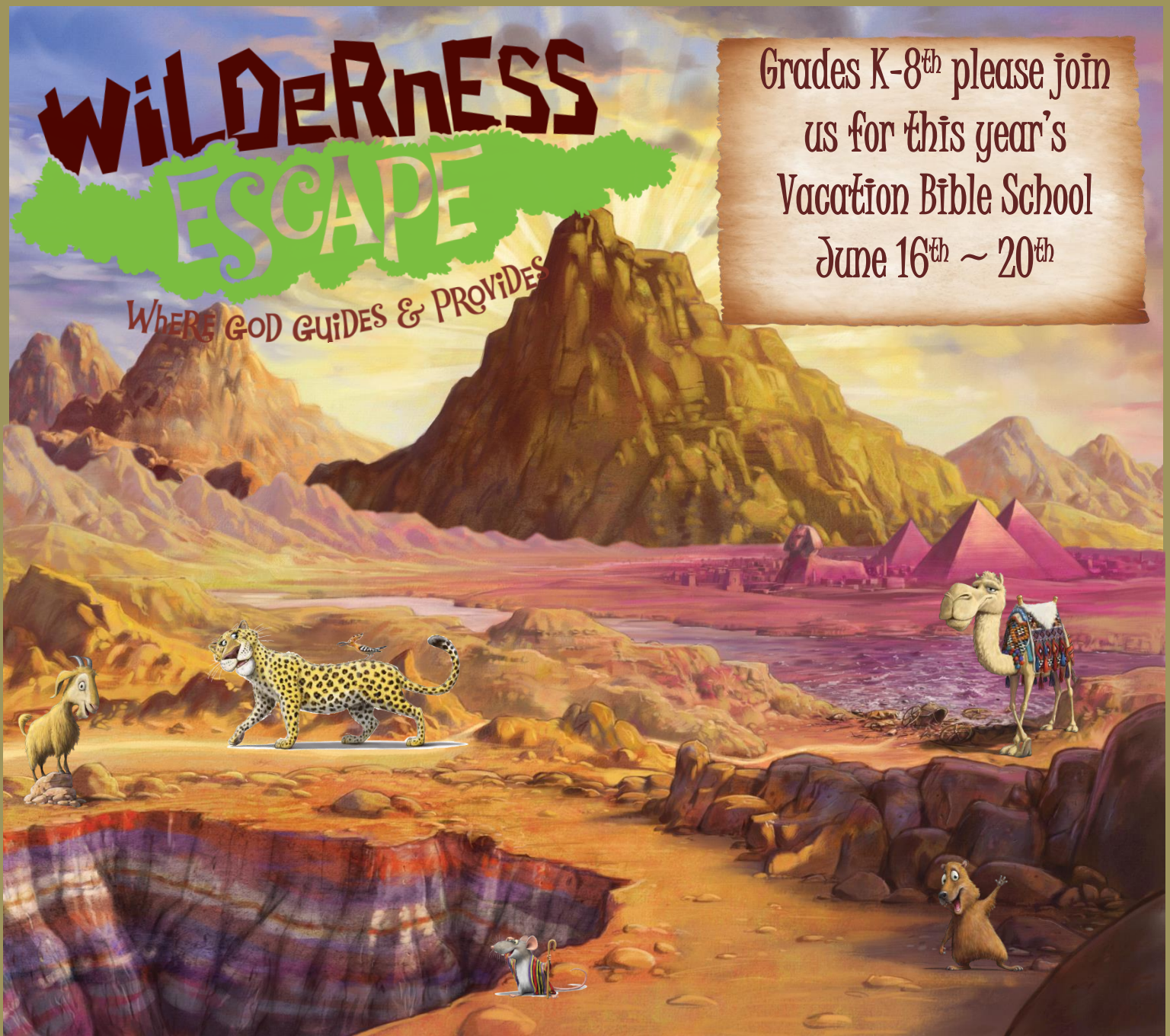

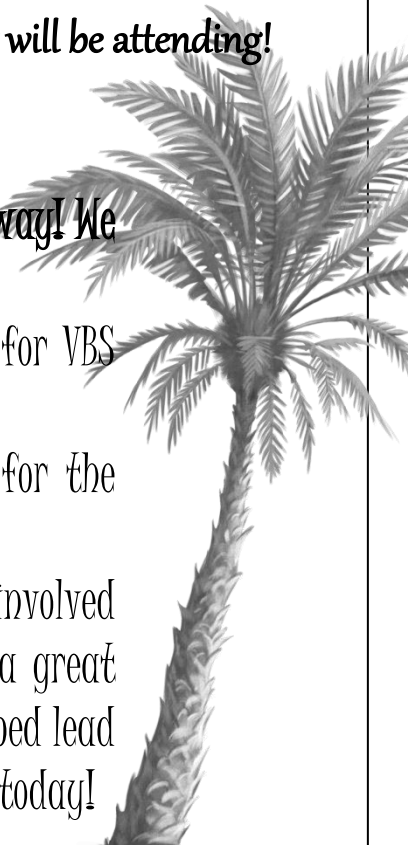
Grades K – 8th are invited to a week of VBS on June 16th – 20th that they will never forget! We will begin pre-registration on June 8th for those who already know they will be attending!

CHRISTIAN RESTORATION ASSOCIATION (CRA)

Christian Restoration Association, or as it is more commonly known, CRA is an agency dedicated to serving the Christian Churches/Churches of Christ. CRA subsidizes the salaries of ministers of new congregations, conducts a lending ministry to churches, sponsors correspondence courses, provides church and ministerial counseling, holds evangelistic meetings, offers leadership training, and publishes *The Restoration Herald* and other printed materials and study helps. There is also a bookstore on premises. The CRA center is located in Mason, Ohio with offices, library, conference and seminar rooms which provide more adequate space for the CRA to conduct its ministries. 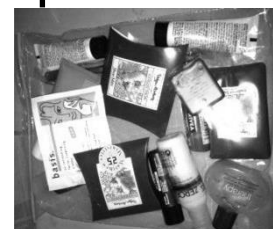


MATTHEW 25 RESPONDS TO SEVERE TORNADO OUTBREAK

Article on Matthew 25 Ministry Website: UPDATED MONDAY, MAY 5, 2014 1:37 PM EST

Matthew 25: Ministries is responding to the devastation left behind after a severe tornado outbreak that is creating destruction in the South and Midwest, including Mayflower and Vilonia, AR and Tupelo, MS. Matthew 25's advance team, led by CEO and Disaster Relief Coordinator Tim Mettey left on Monday, April 28 with Matthew 25's full complement of specialized Disaster Response vehicles, including three customized pick-up trucks, two co-branded delivery trucks and an ice maker capable of producing 10,000 pounds of ice a day. The trucks were loaded with relief supplies including personal kits, paper products, tarps, blankets and beverages. The team will continue to establish distribution sites and also deliver products to hard-hit neighborhoods.

Matthew 25 Ministries Pill Bottle Program

You can help improve the quality of health care in hospitals and health clinics in developing countries by saving and donating basic medical supplies such as pill bottles. In developing countries, medicines—when actually obtainable—are often dispensed into hands, pockets, leaves or any other available container. Matthew 25: Ministries accepts donations of basic medical supplies such as empty pill bottles to help improve health care quality in developing nations. Donations of clean, unlabeled pill bottles help the poorest of the poor in many ways. Medicine can be distributed in sterile containers; pill bottles that are not appropriate for shipping which are recycled for cash that goes towards Matthew 25: Ministries' programs. By doing this plastic recycling program it helps keep thousands of bottles out of landfills each year and helps change a life overseas. If you are interested you can place a nickel, dime, or quarter in each pill bottle and it will help Matthew 25: Ministries with shipping costs. Matthew 25: Ministries also accepts the following types of empty pill bottles: Prescription pill bottles, large and small pill bottles, pill bottles with and without child resistant caps, and over-the-counter pill bottles. We ask that if you have any pill bottles lying around the house bring them to West Side and we will deliver them to Matthew 25: Ministries for you! Thanks!

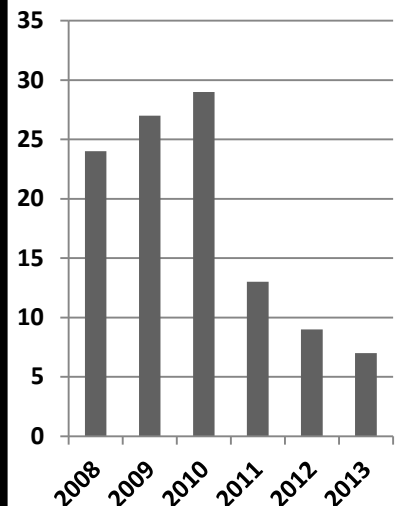
kindergarten through 12th grade.
