



But life has changed. Now, as an adult, I no longer get a summer break. In fact, for me, summer is one of my busiest times of year. In addition to my normal responsibilities, I have week long events like Vacation Bible School, church camp, and vacation. Don't get me wrong, I love all of those things, and couldn't imagine life without them, but this time that used to be care free as a kid, is full of lots of things to worry and care about.

Sometimes, I think we all long for summer. For those days of our youth where we didn't have the stresses we have today. Perhaps we can have summer. Perhaps, all the things we worry about, all the things we stress over, all the problems we face, really aren't that big of a deal. Perhaps, we need to step back, and evaluate all that we have going on, and decide, I am going to reduce my load this summer. I am going to rest.

Rest is something God wants for us. When God created the world, on the seventh day, after He had formed us, He took that day as a day of rest.
