Some Food For Thought



I absolutely love our church and our church family. And one of the things I love the most is the growing outlook for serving people.

West Side has a long tradition of serving others. For many years a group from our congregation has volunteered an entire morning on the second Wednesday of the month with the Lebanon Food Pantry. In that capacity we have shown the Lebanon community immense amounts of love.

While that ministry is terrific, at one time, it was about the only act of love we showed our community on a consistent basis. However, that is no longer the case. In the past few years, through the efforts of our JoyBelles and our Evangelism Team, our congregation has really taken our approach to community involvement to a new level. Let me identify how.

Led by our JoyBelles, West Side developed partnerships with the Elizabeth New Life Center here in Lebanon by throwing baby showers and collecting bottles with change. Not only has the JoyBelles increased our focus there, but they have also partnered with and brought up awareness for sex trafficking in our local and state situations. We have also started a partnership with the rape crises center by making and providing love pillows.

It was also our JoyBelles who started our partnership with Matthew 25 Ministries. Now every two months we travel down to help Matthew 25 be prepared when disasters and emergencies strike. Our last visit on April 11th we had the privilege of making toiletry packs, the first thing handed out when Matthew 25 arrives on scene. It's the simple things like shampoo and toothpaste that is greatly needed when a tornado touches down or a hurricane blows through.

These partnerships have led us to take more active steps of service. Starting on April 30th we will begin a partnership at the Lebanon Community Center were we will join other area churches in providing meals to those in need in our community. In this area of service we will be able to directly demonstrate the love of Christ with people.

In these steps over the last few years we have begun in tangible ways living out Jesus' words ... "Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink? When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you? The King will reply, "I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me." (Matthew 25:37-40) When we serve people we are serving Jesus. I am proud of the growing outlook to loving and leading people to a life changing relationship with Jesus through acts of service that is growing in our congregation. Keep up the good work.

Several years ago our Missions Team decided to live out Jesus' mission plan in Acts 1:8. Jesus said, "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Monthly Recipe

Baked Parmesan Zucchini

(http://tinyurl.com/me7kedk)

Vegetarian • Gluten free • 30 mins to make • Serves 4

INGREDIENTS

4zucchini, quartered lengthwise, 1/2 cup grated Parmesan, 1/2 teaspoon dried thyme, 1/2 teaspoon dried oregano, 1/2 teaspoon dried basil, 1/4 teaspoon garlic powder, Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper, to taste, 2 tablespoons olive oil, 2 tablespoon chopped fresh parsley leaves

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Coat a cooling rack with nonstick spray and place on a baking sheet; set aside. In a small bowl, combine Parmesan, thyme, oregano, basil, garlic powder, salt and pepper, to taste. Place zucchini onto prepared baking sheet. Drizzle with olive oil and sprinkle with Parmesan mixture. Place into oven and bake until tender, about 15 minutes. Then broil for 2-3 minutes, or until crisp and golden brown. Serve immediately, garnish with parsley, if desired.
