

#### Recipe of the Month - Sweet and Salty S'mores

40 Ritz Crackers 3 Large Hershey Chocolate Bars 10 Large Marshmallows Cut in half

### Some Food For Thought

In the next eight weeks, two major American holidays will be upon us ... Mother's Day and Father's Day. We have set aside these two days to honor our parents who for the vast majority of us have sacrificed in amazing ways to shape us into the people we are today. With those two holidays as our back drop, I like use this season of the year to focus on family, because family is the backbone of society.

After God had finished creating, He noticed the man. The man was all alone, which is something God did not like. Genesis 2:18 says, "The LORD God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a helper suitable for him.""



So God gave Adam the task of naming all of the animals. While he was naming the animals, it became apparent to Adam that God had created the animals with both sexes, male and female. But for Adam, no suitable helper was found. Unlike the animals, Adam was alone. Genesis 2:21-23 says, "So the LORD God caused the man to fall into a deep sleep; and while he was sleeping, he took one of the man's ribs and closed up the place with flesh. Then the LORD God made a woman from the rib he had taken out of the man, and brought her to the man. The man said, "This is now bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called 'woman, for she was taken out of the man."

In that simple act, Adam naming the animals, realizing he was alone compared to the animal kingdom, and then God creating Eve, God created the family. Ever since that day family has been a core component to the human experience. Unfortunately, it seems today that the definition of marriage and the definition of family is being rewritten.

Sometimes that rewriting is good, especially in the sense of extended families and blended families growing stronger. But in many senses that rewriting is not good, such as when divorce and having children out of wed-lock distorts God's plan for family.

Coming up in May we are going to take a look at God's plan for families and how we, living in a distorted world, can honor God's plan. We are going to begin the month by talking about Baby Dedications and what that means for the children we are raising. We are going to look at how Christian education begins in the home and is only supplemented in the church. We are going to examine the role more and more grandparents are playing in the lives of their grandchildren and what that means going forward. And we will look at marriage, and God's plan for marriage.

Family is the core of God's plan for community. Join us in May as we strive to understand it a little better.

Christian Missionary Fellowship, or CMF as it is more commonly called, began their ministry in Ethiopia in the 1960's, even though it was briefly interrupted in the 70's and 80's by the communist regime. With their work renewed in the early 90's, CMF focused on leadership development in a national partner church and now has parallel ministries in several areas of Ethiopia.

West Side supports Adrian and Jennifer, who minister to an economically deprived people in the village of Maseru in Western Ethiopia. The Fehl's negotiated an

agreement with the regional government which allowed them to begin a Community Health Program, focusing on those affected by HIV/AIDS, leprosy, and the orphaned and vulnerable children living on the streets.

Just this past week, West Side received this email from Adrian and Jennifer sharing the changes that are coming to their ministry. At this time we will wait to see what the Fehl's plans are before making any changes in our mission support.

"Dear Friends at West Side,

Twenty years ago we began our journey in Ethiopia. In June 1996, we flew to Ethiopia on our one-year wedding anniversary to spend the summer on a CMF REACH internship. That summer changed our lives and set us on a course of mission work through today. Ethiopia has changed a lot in the last twenty years....and so have we.

For the past few years we've been sensing God telling us that our time in Ethiopia is coming to a close. In prayer, we've been hearing "move" and "trust" a lot! After many discussions and much prayer, we decided in February that the time for us to leave is soon—this summer.

On June 19<sup>th</sup>, we'll leave Ethiopia and transition to life in America. We don't know what God has in store for us, but we are trusting Him to show us when the time is right. Through the rest of this year, we'll be on furlough in Indiana with CMF. Adrian will continue to be available to the Ethiopia team to help with leadership transition, questions, issues, etc. He'll also be helping with some projects through the CMF home office.

During the fall of 2016, we hope to visit with you to express our appreciation of your partnership with us in ministry. By that time, we also hope to have some idea of what God has next for us (possibly a continuation of ministry with CMF in some capacity). You have been so faithful, and we could not have done our work in Ethiopia without you. We are confident that God will continue His work through the great team that we leave behind.



Thank you for your partnership and prayers and encouragement."
