## RECIPE CORNER

> Broccoli-Cauliflower Salad - Fayne Thacker

1 bunch broccoli (amount banded together)
1 head cauliflower
1 red onion

1 tsp. sugar
2 tsp. vinegar
Hellmann's mayonnaise to moisten well
