



1 tsp. Cinnamon ¾ Cup chopped nuts

½ Cup Butter 2 Cups Flour

1 tsp. Nutmeg 3 Cups chopped Apples



Cream the butter and sugar. Add rest of the ingredients. Bake in a tube or Bundt pan in a 350 degree oven for 45 minutes. Turn out onto a platter; sprinkle with powdered sugar or frost with vanilla frosting.
