



Some Food For Thought

West Side! Thank You! Thank you for your generosity and your faithfulness. Because of your generosity we have been able to do some things in ministry that were only a dream a few years ago. Let me share.

Did you know that each week, no matter what our offering is, 10% of what you give is automatically pulled off the top and given to missions. Did you know that last year we finished the year \$15,416.07 over our budgetary needs? This is the result of West Side Christians practicing the spiritual discipline of tithing as well as stepping up and being incredibly generous with your gifts. We believe and teach that tithing is an act of worship



that all Christians are asked by God to participate in. As a church, we are no different. Because of your generosity, our mission fund had an abundance last year.

With this abundance we were able to help a few of our mission's organizations above and beyond our regular gift. The first was with the International Conference on Mission. In 2014, the host city was Columbus and the host state was Ohio. We were able to help ICOM come to Columbus with a gift of \$500 toward the convention cost. Then in November Jennifer and Adrian Fhel, our missionaries to Ethiopia, were here to visit. Adrian shared that when they return to Ethiopia they will begin working to build a church building and office complex in the capital city. The cost of the project is \$50,000. Because of your generosity, our missions fund was able to give them \$2,000 towards the building of this building.

Not only have we been able to help our missionaries and organizations but we have been able to realize some dreams around our church property. Starting in March we will replace the worn tiles in our basement, kitchen, and bathrooms with a beautiful waterproof epoxy flooring. In addition to that work, plans are being drawn to build a welcome center in our hallway as well as relocate and expand our sound booth area in the sanctuary. All three of these items have been a great need, and because of your generosity they will soon be a reality.

With all the work going on in our building, we are also thinking of our youth. Because of your generosity, we have stepped out in faith and created room in our 2015 budget to hire a part time children's minister. We are still developing and talking through the job description and plan to begin advertising hopefully by the end of March.

With all this going on, I want to say thank you for your faithfulness and generosity. Your gifts are a foundational stone to our desire to love and lead people to a life changing relationship with Jesus. Thank you!

Monthly Recipe

Daddy's Friday Night Pasta Dish (Pinterest)

1 pound angel hair pasta, 1/3 cup olive oil, 1 tablespoon dried basil, 2 teaspoons dried oregano, 1 teaspoon dried parsley, 1 teaspoon dried dill, 1 teaspoon crushed red pepper (or to your liking), 1/2 teaspoon pepper, 1/4 teaspoon salt, 1/3 cup Kalamata olives, halved, 1/3 cup oil packed sun-dried tomatoes, drained of excess oil, 2 tablespoons pickled pepperoncini (optional), 15 ounces mozzarella cheese, shredded, 3-4 red bell peppers, sliced Pepperonis, 2-4 ounces parmesan cheese, freshly grated, Freshly torn basil, for topping...

Preheat the oven to 375 degrees F. Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil. Boil the pasta until al dente. Drain well. While the water comes to a boil add the olive oil (make sure the oil covers the entire bottom of the baking dish, if not add more oil), dried basil, dried parsley, dried oregano, dried dill, crushed red pepper, salt and pepper to a 9 x 13 inch baking dish. To the baking dish add three fourths of the pasta, the olives, sun-dried tomatoes and pepperoncini. Toss well until all the ingredients are evenly distributed. Drizzle the pasta with a little of the reserved oil from the sun-dried tomato jar. If pasta seems a little oily add in a little more angel hair or if you would like to use all the pasta be sure to add more oil to evenly coat all the pasta. Add 3/4 of the mozzarella cheese and then scatter the sliced red peppers over top. At this point it will seem like there are too many peppers, but this is fine. They will cook down. Sprinkle on the remaining mozzarella and evenly place the pepperonis on top. Sprinkle on top 2-4 ounces of parmesan and another drizzle of olive oil. Bake in the preheated oven for 45 to 60 minutes or until the top is browned and the peppers have softened. Remove from the oven and garnish with fresh basil and more parmesan. Cut and eat!
