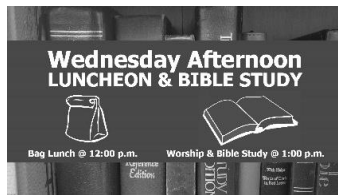
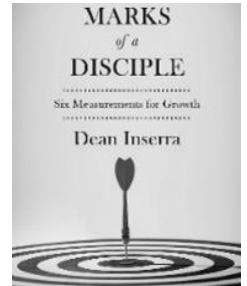

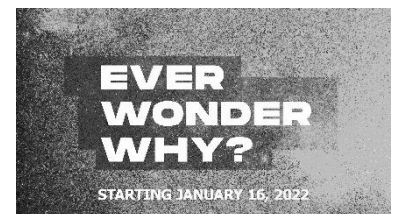
West Side Christmas Cards Don’t forget to pick up your Christmas Cards in The Hub!
