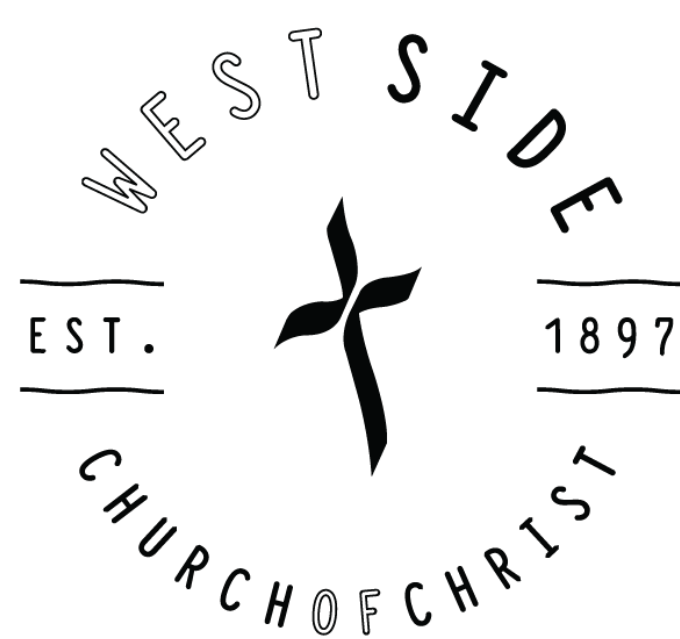


# WELCOME

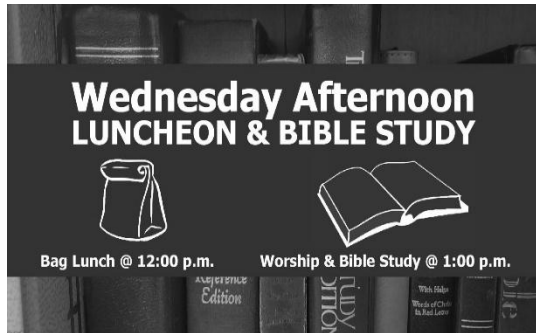
