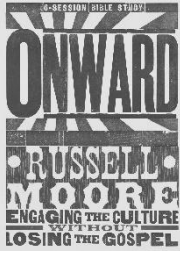

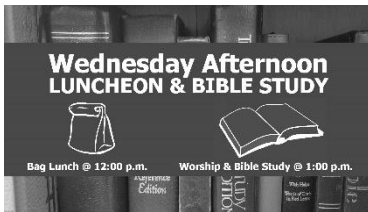
West Side News and Notes
